




3. (above) Type in your e-mail address, then click [Create Password]






4. (above) If you provided the correct e-mail address, this screen should appear. Click [Got It] and go check your e-mail account.




5. (above) You should immediately receive an e-mail from RROCA-NSW with the subject line “Create Your Password”. If you don’t see this e-mail, it might have gone into your spam/junk folder, check there. Click [Create New Password]




6. (above) If a small pop-up shows up prompting you to adopt a randomly generated password, please select “Don’t Use”. Enter your own password twice, make sure they are exactly the same, then click [Create Password].



- (above) Go back to the Log-in screen in the website and type in your e-mail address and password, then click [Log In]. You should be set to go!



- (above) You can check your log-in status in the main page of the website on the bottom left corner, your name should be showing here. If you are using someone else's computer, or on a public computer, make sure you log-out afterward. To do this, click on your name, a dropdown menu should appear with a log-out button in it.



(above) Now you can enjoy all members only contents including Member's Toolbox, various magazine downloads, and access the Bulletin.
